1. Payments in Africa must be cash(US\$) or Credit card. VISA and MasterCard Credit cards can be used in Africa, however there will be an additional **5%** charge to the total amount on Credit cards.
2. Price for Hunter includes: Hunting vehicle, lodging, all meals, bottled water, sodas, daily laundry service, tracker, skinner, camp staff, professional hunter and field preparation of trophies
3. Price for Observer includes: Lodging, all meals, bottled water, sodas, daily laundry service and camp staff.
4. Delivery of trophies to an approved South African Taxidermy is included in the price. (With in a 120 mile range from Sediba Nkwe Hunting Safari's)
5. Transportation from and to Airport is **not include**.
6. The cost of your airfare is not included in your Safari price.
7. Dipping and Shipping are not included in prices.
8. Taxidermy works is not included in prices.
9. Itinerary is contingent on Airline flight schedule.
10. In the unlikely event that the US Dollar devalues & falls below ZAR12 to the Dollar, we have to raise quoted prices.
11. Cancellation policy: In the case of cancellation, you will lose deposit paid, or in some cases we will endeavour to transfer your hunt to the following year, contingent on approval.
12. All animals wounded will be paid in full.

Things you need to know:

- You need a valid Passport to enter South Africa.
- If you travel with **children under 18**, you will need **original birth certificate** and a signed letter from both parents giving permission for the child to leave the country and enter South Africa
- You do **not need any shots** for South Africa; however it will be wise to go on a Malaria course just to be on the safe side.
- You do not need any permits if you are a bow hunter just an Invitation letter.
- No permits are required to bring a bow into South Africa. Checking as normal luggage.
- Regardless of whether you buy a package or daily rate hunt, additional animals are available on the pricelist for the year hunting.
- We advise you to take out a trip insurance plan for your Safari.
- No Safari dates will be reserved until a deposit has been received.
- On your first meeting with your P.H. or Guide, clearly discuss the hunt plan, your priorities and any special circumstances, i.e. health problems, etc. Your P.H. is extremely qualified and is there to make your hunt as pleasurable as possible; however, he is not a mind reader.
- South Africa's seasons are reversed from yours with April through October being the cool, dry fall and winter months. For most part, daytime temperatures are pleasant and range from 60 to 80 degrees F. In South Africa snowstorms are a rare exception, but temperatures can vary from 40 degrees at night to 80 degrees during the day - so prepare for all conditions.
- **You need proof of ownership on the rifles you bring into South Africa. (4457 custom form)**
- **Important!** All firearms must be declared with US Customs before leaving the States. Get this done well before you leave. The location of the nearest Customs office can usually be found in the blue pages of your telephone guide. Many Customs offices are lightly staffed and there are not always agents on hand. Call ahead for an appointment. This does not register your firearms in anyway, as you will receive the only record of listing; it's ***called a 4457 custom deceleration form***. **Do not lose this record!** Without it, you will not be able to bring back your rifles into the US. Keeping it with your passport should prevent it from being misplaced.
- On entering South Africa, you should also fill out an import firearm permit, with the serial numbers, model and calibres of your firearms. Having this information handy, will prevent you having to open your rifle cases at this time. Your firearms must be presented to a Customs official and the serial numbers you registered will be checked. Your firearm permit must be stamped and retained by you until your departure. Put it with your passport to prevent loss. **Your firearm permit will be dated as valid only until your departure date. Be certain you do not put down a date prior to your actual departure.** You will also have to supply an in-country address to Immigration officials when arriving. Have this information handy. It is sometimes not enough to say you are going hunting in the bush at such and such a camp. You will use your Safari Company's home address, **PO Box 45, Maasroom, Limpopo Province, 0623, South Africa.**
- Few travellers are aware that cameras and electronic equipment are not covered by airline baggage insurance. If you read the fine print, airlines specifically disclaim liability for these items. Place your cameras in your carry on/hand luggage.
- There will be a good supply of water, sodas, African beer, wine and limited supply of other liquor in camp. **Should you have a favourite, pick it up at the airport's duty free shop.**
- Certain species cannot be imported into the US, unless you have obtained the necessary CITIES permit before the trophies are shipped. In South Africa you must have the necessary CITIES permit before your hunt.
- South Africa is 2 hours ahead of GMT and 7 hours ahead of New York time.
- Tips: It is normally 10% of your Safari to your PH and 5% to camp staff. It is not a must to tip - this is at your own discretion. Your outfitter could advise you on this.

Firearm Regulation

Regulation:

- You can bring two shotguns or rifles in their own cases. (Unloaded)
- Sporting firearms consisting of no more than one rifle case, airline approved, with a lock container, not more than 2 rifles and one sporting pistol. **11 lbs/5kg of ammunition in a separate locked ammo case.**
- For ammunition use a pistol case of rigid wood, metal or strong sturdy plastic case, containing not more than 11 lbs/5kg of ammunition separate and locked.
- Loose ammunition is not acceptable. It must be a separate locked ammo case.
- **Remember your 4457 Customs Form**

Documents must reach us 25 DAYS before arrival.

3. COPY OF RETURN TICKET (itinerary)
4. PROOF OF OWNERSHIP FOR FIREARM (US CUSTOMS FORM 4457)
5. SAPS 520
